Greetings!

We are glad to bring it to your attention that, we have successfully completed one more successful quarter in the service of marginalized and underprivileged people. The Last quarter was loaded with activities and achievements for us at MESCO and MESCO Education Society. Once again this year our EAS and HCES students achieved milestones in academics. 57 Education Adoption Scheme students in the SSC exam and 39 Education Adoption Scheme students in the HSC exam got distinction. We at MESCO not only provide financial aid to the underprivileged students but we are also doing multiple activities for the holistic development of such students. During the last quarter we successfully conducted group and individual counseling sessions for SSC and HSC passed students, our dedicated education counselors helped students in selecting the best career options. We feel proud to share a news with all our donors and well wishers that our 8 students got job in multi-national companies such as Accenture, Infosys, TCS etc. MESCO started a new charitable dispensary at the existing Physiotherapy Center premises at Kausa, it was inaugurated on 13th June 2022. During the last quarter, we were able to service 2192 patients at our charitable clinic and 590 patients at our charitable physiotherapy center, Kausa. During this quarter MESCO successfully provided financial aid to 33 patients under life-saving chemotherapy and high-cost major surgeries, monthly medicines were provided to 62 patients, 14 patients were assisted for minor surgeries and diagnostic tests, 25 dialysis patients have been supported under a six-month dialysis scheme, and 11 patients under sustained dialysis support scheme. This year during Ramadhan we could able to raise the highest Zakat as compared to the previous year therefore we would like to extend our gratitude for your generous donations may Allah bless you and your family. A Capacity building workshop for the staff of MESCO and the MESCO Education Society had been organized on 18th June at Crescent English High School Kausa to maximize staff potential and to increase the effectiveness of their daily tasks by boosting their capabilities at the workplace, Mr. Adrian Rosario and Ms. Kinjal Maru were the resource persons.

## MEDICAL DEPARTMENT

The Medical Aid department carried out its monthly activities under various schemes. During this quarter MESCO successfully provided financial aids to 33 beneficiaries under life saving medical aid scheme for the major surgeries, chemotherapy and high cost medicines

treatment taking place in government hospitals. Monthly medicines were provided to 62 patients suffering from chronic ailments and 14 patients were assisted for the minor surgeries and diagnostic test under Medical Aid scheme, 25 dialysis patients has been supported under Six months Dialysis scheme and 11 beneficiaries under Sustained dialysis support scheme.

## Gratitude Story

"A yet another effort towards contributing to well being and health of the society". A 5 years old Tejal suffering from Congenital Anomaly short femur required implant surgery at LTMG hospital.

While the child looked forward towards walking without disability, her family being financially disabled has tried to contribute from every possible sources for the child's surgery but was unable to do it. Tejal's father is a tempo driver and most of his earnings out of his salary of 10,000/- INR got spent on the family and children's education expenses, with lots of hope patient's father approached MESCO for the medical aid. Luckily, she got selected under lottery system and received the balanced amount from MESCO this lead



to a successful surgery and has bought back efficiency in the child's quality of living. Parents are thank full to the donors of MESCO for the timely donation for their daughter's surgery.

The First cycle of Sewing Machine distribution will be held on 7th July 2022 in the office premises. Total 12 Sewing Machines will be distributed. We have Ration Support Distribution Scheme in which we distributed dry ration in 10 areas to around 417 families. We also distributed ration to the 34 elderly people of Kaynaat Old Age Home, Uttan. Total 451 beneficiaries were helped in June 2022.

## Success Story:

Fauzia is 34 divorcee, stays in a heavy deposit house, the deposit money was arranged by her husband on an agreement that he wouldn't give any maintenance to her in future. Fauzia's life completely changed as she was finding it extremely difficult to manage her expenses along with her three children single handedly with no money in hand at all. Fortunately she knew stitching and approached MESCO for sewing machine, after her trade test, she received the machine from the trust in September, 2019. She is currently earning 7000-8000/- pm. She is thankful to MESCO for the assistance provided because now she is able to live life with dignity.



## CLINICS DEPARTMENT

Clinics Department has provided quality primary care services to 2192 patients through Medical-Aid Dispensary, Mumbra, Amrut Nagar, and a Total of 590 patients through Umair Khopekhar Charitable Physiotherapy Centre, Kausa during the reporting quarter. In addition we have also started a charitable primary care clinic at our physiotherapy centre from 13th June 2022 in the evening from 6.00 p.m. to 9.00 p.m. We extend our heartfelt thanks to Ms. Shabana Kazi (Dockyard road) for their in-kind medicine donations.

### Sewing Machine Distribution & Ration Support:

Every month we are taking details of beneficiaries on phone every 4th day of the month in the given format. Later we are doing lottery through software for Zakat and Non Zakat cases separately. We are calling beneficiaries at office along-with documents and they are being registered, after every quarter we conduct trade test and interview at our office, selected cases are called in the office to collect the Sewing Machine.

## MES, Crescent English High School Jr. College

Webinar was organized by Kalsekar Education & Welfare trust conducted by Maharashtra Dyslexia Association for Primary teachers. The resource persons were Ms. Kaschit Mishra & Priyamwada Kotris. The objective was to identify specific learning disability, to understand difference between Dyslexia, Dysgraphia & Dyscalculia, to know about how to identify disorder among students through checklist, to get awareness about how to deal with students facing with disorder at early stage & classroom strategies (inclusive practices). It was a good learning session where teachers understood that special cases of such children to be forwarded to the government recognized centers for the remedial if there is no improvement noticed in the child. Every child is special and every child should go under checklist (Dali) & children can overcome from these disorders through special trained remedial instructors only. He decided to acquire a technical skill and so he joined Electrician course in MES-VTC. After successfully completing the course in 2020, Maaz is working with SASA Creator as Electrician with salary of Rs.9000 per month. Now he has also completed his HSC.
