- Ms. Shabana Khan attended Online Training on POC SO Act, 2012 by Adv. Aileen Marques.

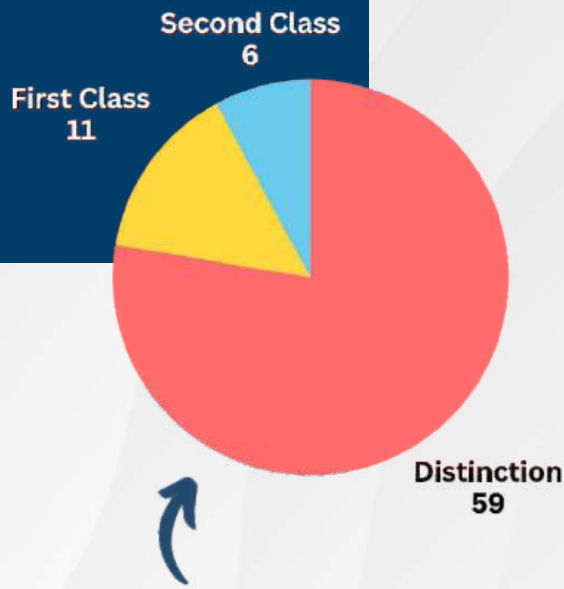

### Faiz's Story: From Crisis to Classroom

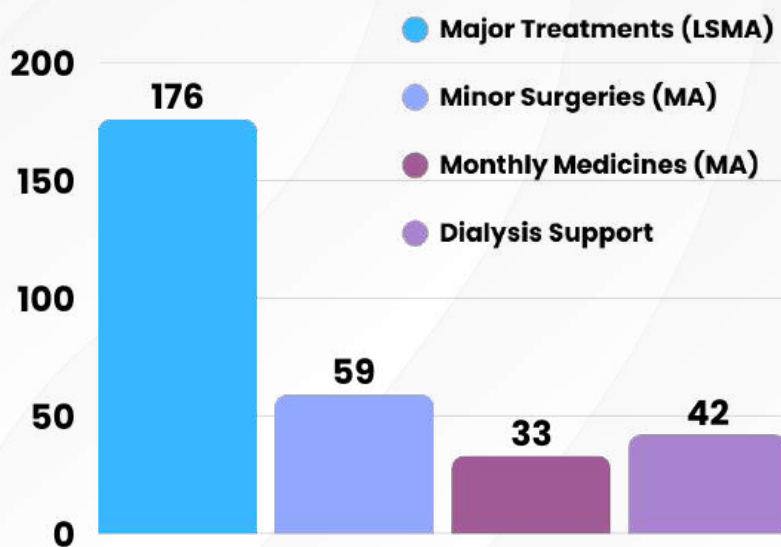

### RATION SUPPORT (Monthly)

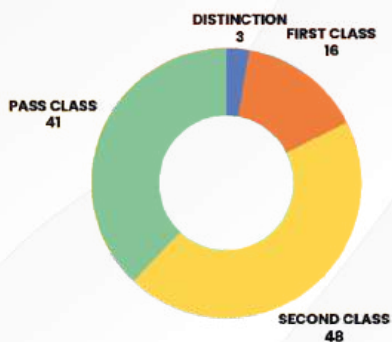
**457** beneficiaries across 10 locations received essential dry ration kits, including elderly residents of Kaynaat Old Age Home, Uttan.



## School Adoption

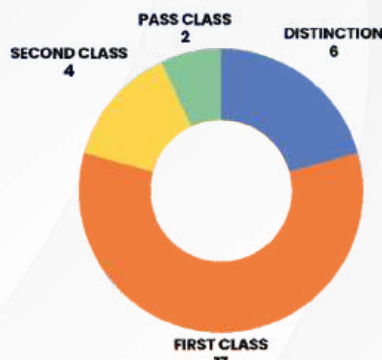
- Extra classes for Std. X students began on 15<sup>th</sup> April 2025 at R.C. Mahim and Bandra Petit Urdu School.

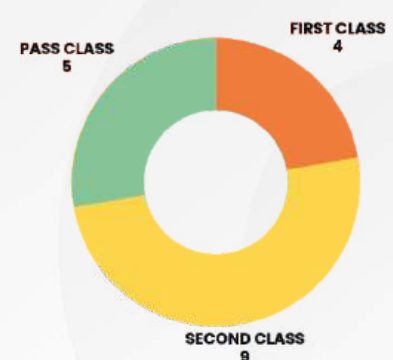
#### R.C Mahim Mun. Urdu School

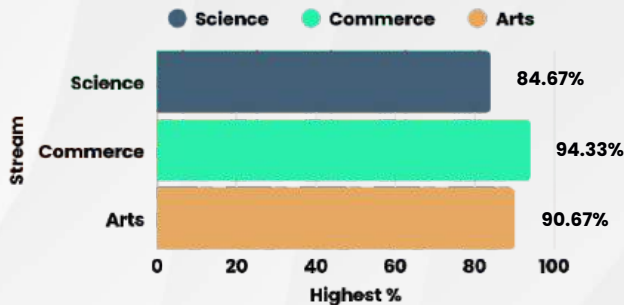
## Crescent English High School & Jr College
